<u>Travel Options for reaching Garmisch-Partenkirchen for the</u> <u>17th International European Forum on System Dynamics and Innovation in Food Networks</u> <u>February 13-17, 2023</u>

Garmisch-Partenkirchen can easily be reached either from Munich or from Innsbruck. It is located at the train connection between Munich and Innsbruck with a travel time of slightly more than an hour.

From Munich central station to Garmisch

Option 1: Take train to Garmisch-P. (direction Innsbruck), about 1:20 hours (tickets < 25 EURO) Schedule: https://www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml

Option 2: Take Bus (Flixbus, www.flixbus.com/bus/germany) to Garmisch, about 1:15 hours (tickets for < 10 EURO)

From Munich airport to Garmisch

Option 1: "S-Bahn" (train) from Munich airport to Munich central station,

then train to Garmisch-P., about 2:20 hours

Option 2: Take Bus (Flixbus, www.flixbus.com/bus/germany) to Garmisch-P. via Munich central station (direct bus, no change of buses), about 2:15 hours (tickets for about 20 EURO)

From Innsbruck central station to Garmisch:

1. Take train to Garmisch-P. (direction Munich), about 1:20 hours (tickets for < 20 EURO) Schedule: https://www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml

2. Take bus (Flixbus, www.flixbus.com) to Garmisch-P., about 1:10 hours (tickets for about 10 EURO)

Train tickets can be purchased at the train stations, no reservations needed. For Flixbus it is advised to reserve tickets and seats through the internet.

For return travel use the same connections, just backwards.
